To: Shipowners/Operators and Masters of Merchant Vessels

Subject: Application for Statutory Certificate of Competency

1. For the application of Permanent Licenses, the party in interest should apply before a Panamanian Consulate Office (Refer to Merchant Marine Circular No.49).

- 2. The party in interest shall present the following documents, at the moment of the application:
- a. Copy of the passport of personal identity card.
- b. Copy of the discharge book.
- c. Copy of reference letters.
- d. Copy of the Certificate of Competency or a Nautical Academic Degree.
- e. Medical Certificates.
- f. Four photographs approximately 4cm by 3-1/2cm.
- g. The application's fee in U.S. dollars (Refer to Merchant Marine Circular No. 55).

3. For the renewal of Permanent Licenses, the party in interest should apply before a Panamanian Consulate Office (Refer to Merchant Marine Circular No.49). Such application shall be presented six months before or after the expiration date of the certificate.

- 2. The party in interest holding in Panamanian license shall present, at the moment of the application the following documentation:
- a. Copy of the passport or personal identity card.
- b. Copy of the Certificate of Competency issued by Panama.
- c. Medical Certificates.
- d. Three photographs approximately 4cm by 3-1/2cm.
- e. Copy of the Discharged Book.
- f. The application's fee in U.S. dollars (Refer to Merchant Marine Circular No. 55)
