To: Ship-owners/Operators, Company Security Officers, Private Security

Companies, Legal Representatives of Panamanian Flagged Vessels, Panamanian Merchant Marine Consulates and Recognized Organizations

Subject: Rates to the Recognized Private Maritime Security Companies (PMSC)

MMC-228 - Use of Armed Security Personnel on board Panama Flagged

Vessels (online application).

- 1. The purpose of this Merchant Marine Circular is to officially communicate that on December 11th, 2014 was published in the Official Gazette No. 27678, the Resolution JD No. 038-2014 dated November 12th, 2014, whereby the Panama Maritime Authority establishes the new fees will be paid the Private Maritime Security Companies (PMSC).
- **2.** According to article 1 from Resolution JD No. 038-2014 the following fees are established for the Private Maritime Security Companies (PMSC).
 - - *These payments must be made by certified check payable to the Maritime Authority of Panama, nonrefundable, submitted at time of application.

*The payment of the annual fee must be paid in this form:

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- Private Maritime Security Companies (PMSC) authorized by the Panama Maritime Authority from 2012 until December 31, 2014, must make payment of annual fee in advance on or before January 31 of each year.
- Private Maritime Security Companies (PMSC) authorized by the Panama Maritime Authority in 2015 until now, must make payment of annual fee no later than one (1) month after the entry into force of the Resolution of Authorization. (Resolution JD No. 002-2015).

The second and subsequent payments of the annual fee should be made on the following calendar year, taking as reference the date on which the Resolution of Authorization entered into force.

c) All payments can be made at the offices of the Panama Maritime Authority and the Merchant Marine Consulates in the period described above in order to avoid the withdrawal of the authorization granted, with immediate suspension through a Statement of Objections.
