- 1. The purpose of this Circular is to communicate to the users to the Panamanian Registry, the List of States Parties of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended, to which the Panama Maritime Authority recognizes the Certificates of Competency (CoC) and Certificates of Proficiency (CoP), in compliance with Regulations I/2 and I/10 of the 1978 STCW Convention, as amended, and in reference to Circular MSC.1/Circ.1163 (last version) of the International Maritime Organization (IMO), which lists the States Parties that have communicated information which demonstrates that full and complete effect is given to the provisions of the Convention (White List).
